

Emmett Dudley Hallaway

February 17, 1927 - January 8, 2019

Mr. Emmett Dudley Hallaway, 91, longtime Bartlesville resident, died at 2:30 A.M. on Tuesday, January 8, 2019 at the Forrest Manor Nursing Home in Dewey.

Memorial services for Mr. Hallaway will be held at 10:30 A.M. on Monday, January 14, 2019 at the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ with Mr. David Hammonds officiating. Memorial services and cremation are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory. Mr. Hallaway was born in Bartlesville on February 17, 1927 the son of John and Helen (Waller) Hallaway. He grew up and received his education in Bartlesville until joining the circus as a young man for two years. He entered the U.S. Army on June 13, 1945 serving in Germany begining in December of 1945 and receiving his Honorable Discharge from active duty on November 23, 1946. He then remained on Reserve status until earning a retirement from the Army Reserve. Following his active duty, he returned to Bartlesville where he was employed with National Zinc for over 20 years. He then attended machinist school and was then employed as a machinist with Reda Pump until his retirement. Mr.

Mr. Hallaway became a school bus driver for the Bartlesville Public Schools until becoming disabled as a quadriplegic due to a fall in 2003. He was a member of the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ. Mr. Hallaway was married to Dorothy Lou Ellis on September 16, 1950 in Bartlesville. They made their home in Bartlesville for most of their married life and Mrs. Hallaway preceded him in death on July 18, 2015.

Mr. Hallaway is survived by his daughter, Jerri McCollum of Bartlesville, two sons, John Russell "Rusty" Hallaway and wife Jennifer and E. Dudley Hallaway II and wife Leslie all of Bartlesville, four brothers and sisters, Elizabeth Miller of Cherryhill, North Carolina, Richard Jones and Mary Kay Misenheimer both of Wewoka and Mary Lou McWilliams of Muskogee, 12 grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and seven brothers and sisters.


