Janet "Sue" (Pattillo) McCauley, 68, of Barnsdall, Oklahoma passed away on Friday, April 3, 2020. She was born in Tulsa, OK on April 15, 1951, to Jack Charles Pattillo and Mildred Naomi (Bracken) Pattillo. She grew up in the Skiatook, OK area and attended Skiatook Public Schools until graduation in 1969.
