



Randy Dean Weatherly

July 21, 1957 - December 28, 2018

Weatherly, Randy Dean, 61, Vice President of Ambler Architects, passed away unexpectedly on December 28, 2018.

Randy was born in Wichita, Kansas on July 21, 1957 to parents Lee Roy and Wanda (Trammell) Weatherly.

He was a graduate of the 1975 class at South-East High School in Wichita, Kansas.

In 1980, Randy received a Bachelors Degree in Landscape Architecture from Kansas State.

On July 5, 1980 he married Barb Keeler in Clay Center, Kansas.

In the early 1980's, Randy began his association with Ambler Architects. Randy was very involved in the Bartlesville Community. When he and Barb first moved to Bartlesville, he started his own business out of his backyard named Rainbow Connection Stained Glass which lead him to be heavily involved in Sunfest for many years. He was a Scoutmaster of Boy Scout Troop 104 and served on the Board for both the Girl Scouts and the Boy Scouts. Randy was a member of Daybreak Rotary and was Head Elf of Fantasy Land of Lights. Randy was appointed to the Oklahoma State Board of Architects, Landscape Architects & Interior Designers by the Governor on July 1, 2001. He served as Chairman for 8 years and was still on the board when he passed. He was President of CLARB (Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards) in 2015/2016.

In his spare time, Randy loved riding his Harley and restoring his 1964 ½ Mustang Convertible. He also enjoyed an occasional game of golf and loved to go to the shooting range. Randy enjoyed relaxing on the back deck with a good cigar, Crown on the rocks, family, friends, and his dog Abbie.

Randy is survived by his wife Barb; his son Josh; and a daughter Katie Zaun and her husband Thomas, all of Bartlesville. Other survivors include his father Lee Roy and wife

Jo Weatherly of Wichita, Kansas; and a brother Michael and wife Sandy Weatherly of Wewoka, Oklahoma. He was preceded in death by his mother Wanda.
