Mr. Allen Milton McWilliams, 80, of Nowata died Friday morning, April 19, 2013 at his home.

Allen Milton McWilliams was born on October 28, 1932, southwest of Delaware, Oklahoma to Frank McWilliams and Anna Belle Truitt McWilliams. He attended school at Elm Bend, then Delaware, Oklahoma, where he graduated in May, 1952. On July, 11, 1952, he married Laura Lue Campbell, in Bentonville, Arkansas.

He served two years in the Army, and attended OSU Tech in Okmulgee, Oklahoma, for two years. In 1959, he returned to Nowata to work for Dugan Myers Furniture, as an appliance repairman in air conditioning and heating until the store closed in 1970. At that time he started his own business-MAC's Heating & Air, which he retired from in 2000, after 30 years.

Allen is survived by a son, Robert Dale McWilliams, and wife Malinda of Nowata, a daughter, one granddaughter, Sheri Leah Frey, and husband, Bill of Nowata, One grandson, Michael Dale McWilliams and wife Joan, of Nowata, four great-grandchildren, Ethan Chase Walls and Kheri Jo Adeline Frey, of Nowata, Michelle Lee McWilliams and Kendal Nicole McWilliams of Nowata, OK. He is also survived by a brother, Blaine Mason McWilliams, of Nowata, and one sister, Glenda Rae Ridenhour, and husband Bill of Delaware, OK, along with several nieces and nephews.
