Mr. Allen Jerome Morris, 74, longtime Bartlesville resident died Friday in Bartlesville. Mr. Morris was born January 30, 1938 at Wichita, Kansas to Melbourne Ellsworth and Mildred Christine (Fox) Morris. He moved with his parents to the Durango Colorado area as a young boy, and they later moved to Bartlesville and Dewey where he received his education graduating with the Dewey High School class of 1956. He later attended Oklahoma State University at Stillwater. He was married to Darline Ryan on September 8, 1961, in Bartlesville and they had celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary in September of 2011. They made their home in Bartlesville all of their married lives, and they had attended the Tuxedo Assembly of God Church where he was baptized by Rev. McKnight. Mr. Morris was employed by the Page Milk Company as a milkman for several years, and by Charles and Orkin Pest Control companies, by TRW-Reda Pump for 12 years, and by Ogden Allied Cleaning Services as a maintenance worker for over 10 years until his retirement in 1995. His hobbies included hunting, and fishing, and working outdoors in his yard, garden and fish ponds.

Mr. Morris is survived by his wife Darline (Ryan) Morris of the home; by one son Mark Allen Morris, of Bartlesville; by two brothers, Wayne Morris and his wife Majetta of Springfield Missouri and Harry Kenneth Morris and wife Connie of Milton Florida; and by one sister Mrs. Samantha Estes and husband Tom of

Bernice, Oklahoma. He was preceded in death by a daughter Cheryl Lynette as an infant; by his parents Melbourne and Mildred Morris; and by one sister Melba Lee Morris as a child.
