Mrs. Anna Shively Irvin, 89, died Friday, June 24, 2011. She was a resident at the Sterling House South in Bartlesville.

A memorial service for Mrs. Irvin will be held at the First Presbyterian Church of Bartlesville at 11:00 AM Saturday, August 6, 2011. Arrangements are under the direction of Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Anna Ellen Shively Irvin was born near Mt. Summit, Indiana February 5, 1922 to John Shively and Charline (Bouslog) Shively. She spent her early years in southern Indiana, graduating from Mt. Summit High School in 1940. Anna attended Purdue University from 1940 to 1945, earning a bachelor's degree and then a master's degree in Home Economics, focusing on textiles and garment construction. She taught in the Home Economics Department at the University of Nebraska from 1946 to 1948.

Anna married Howard Brownlee Irvin November 21, 1948 in New Castle, Indiana. They moved to Bartlesville in December, 1948 where Howard took a position as a process design Engineer for Phillips Petroleum Company.

During the next 63 years Anna lived in Bartlesville as an active member of her community. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, serving as a Deacon, Elder and Trustee, as well as a member of the Tillie Wallis Circle. She was a member of the local PEO Sisterhood chapter, AAUW and a local garden club. She was a Girl Scout leader, taught sewing classes for young girls at the YWCA and was the meal coordinator for Meals on Wheels in the 1980-90s.

Anna is survived by her daughter, Nancy Irvin Wilkes and her husband Robert Wilkes of Colorado Springs, Colorado, two grandsons Stephen Lee Maddox and Michael Kenton Maddox, one great grandchild and one sister, Sarah McCord of Muncie, Indiana. She was preceded in death by her parents, a brother John C. Shively, and her husband, Howard Irvin.
