Anne Evans, former long time resident of Bartlesville ,Oklahoma, and Whitefish Bay , Wisconsin, passed away peacefully on December 2 , 2020 at St Simeon' s Episcopal Senior Community in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Anne was born March 26 1929 in Buffalo, New York and grew up in New Canaan, Connecticut and New York City. Anne attended St Margaret's School in Waterbury Connecticut. Her parents were Charles Edgar Lee and Claire Johnson of Glen Cove , New York.

Anne was well known and very active in all of the communities in which she lived , volunteering in numerous church, school and community care activities. Anne's husband, Father Robert Evans passed away in March, 2013 at St Simeons.
