She was married to Jack Preston Featherston at Van Buren, Arkansas on February 10, 1951. They moved to Bartlesville to make their home in 1951 and lived in Bartlesville all of their married life. Mrs. Featherston began her career as a telephone operator with Southwestern Bell Telephone in Muskogee which she continued after moving to Bartlesville. She retired from Southwestern Bell with over 30 years of service. She was a member of the Telephone Pioneers of America, was an active walker, loved to cross-stitch and and was a "Grandma" to a lot of kids

Mrs. Featherston is survived by two sisters, Judy Springer of Dewey, and Ann Tipps of Pasadena, Texas and numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, Jack Preston Featherson on August 9, 2009, her parents and one brother, Henry Clay King.
