Arthur Edward Ward beloved husband, father, papa, brother, and uncle passed from this life for his heavenly home on June 16, 2024 surrounded by his loving family at The Journey Home in Bartlesville. Art was 76. He was born on March 2, 1948 in Ramona, Oklahoma to Bert and Mildred (Tucker) Ward. Art was the youngest of three boys.

Art attended elementary and high school in Ramona and graduated in 1966. He was active in athletics and lettered in baseball and basketball. It was during his high school years that he met his soulmate Karen Sue Ballard. Their love story started as teenagers and never wavered. They celebrated 54 years together in February of 2024.

After graduation Art served in the U S army. He was stationed in Germany during his tour of duty. His service completed; he and Karen were married in 1970 at the First Baptist Church in Ramona.
