Audrey Pearl Foote was born on June 7, 1931 in Grand Falls, Newfoundland (Canada) to James Bragg & Catherine Elizabeth (Dyke) Bragg. Surrounded by the family she loved so much, she entered God's Heavenly Kingdom on June 5, 2025.

Following her high school graduation in Grand Falls, Audrey attended and graduated with a nursing degree from Memorial University in St. John's, Newfoundland.

While working as a Registered Nurse in St. John's, she met and married the love of her life, Dr. John D. Foote, who was stationed in St. John's with the United States Air Force. They were united in marriage on July 21, 1955.

After John's honorable discharge they moved to Dewey, OK and established their family home as well as Dewey Veterinary Clinic. Despite the many hours dedicated to assisting John in the Clinic, Audrey also found time to support the Dewey and Bartlesville communities.
