Audrey Genell (Replogle) Stacy was born at the base of Replogle hill in a two-room house located in the Adams Creek area of Wagoner County on July 19, 1942. She went to be with the lord on February 1st, 2025 at the age of 82 surrounded by family. Audrey attended ProgressiveGrade School and then Catoosa high school graduating as an honor student in 1960. Audrey attended Thomas Church from birth until her marriage.

Audrey met Vernon Warren Stacy at Thomas church and they were married on July 10, 1960, at the home of Rev. Bill & Lavonn Stone in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. They made their home in Liberal , Kansas where Vernon worked for the City of Liberal, moving back to Oklahoma in 1964. They moved to Nowata in 1974, building a house that Vernon and his friends built from pine logs they cut and pulled out with mule teams.
