Austin Parker Nagele, 34, restaurant manager, passed away unexpectedly at his Austin, Texas home.

Austin was born on May 22, 1982 in Bartlesville to parents Marc and Nancy (Dickey) Nagele. Austin was a member of the 2000 graduating class from Bartlesville High School. He attended KU for a while, then attended Vatterott College, where he earned his Electrical and Mechanical Degree. Austin worked in several restaurants in Bartlesville and Tulsa, and he had moved to Austin, Texas in August of 2016, where he managed a Taco Bell Cantina restaurant. Austin had an adventurous spirit, and his passion was skydiving. He did numerous jumps around Oklahoma, and had gone several times in Texas as well.
