Avis Marie Snyder, 60, resident of Bartlesville, died Monday January 12, 2015 in her home.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Monday January 19, 2015 at the East Cross United Methodist Church in Bartlesville, with Rev. Jeff Burress, and Rev. Chad Perceful pastors of the Church officiating. Interment will be at a later date, in the Haskell County Cemetery at Sublette Kansas under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

A Memorial Fund has been established in her name c/o of East Cross United Methodist Church, 820 S.E. Madison Blvd. Bartlesville, OK. 74006.

Mrs. Snyder was born January 26, 1954 in Sublette, Kansas to DeLoss and Mary Beth (McFerrin) Starke. She was raised and received her education there, graduating in 1972 as Valedictorian of her class at Sublette High School. She later attended Ft. Hays State College from 1972-1975, and received her Bachelor's Degree in 1981 from Southwest Missouri State in Springfield, MO. She moved to Bartlesville later that year to begin working as a Computer Analyst for Phillips Petroleum Company where she was employed until her retirement in 2012. She was married to James Snyder from 1975-1986. She was a very active member of East Cross United Methodist Church,

where she served on several boards and committees, and was involved in the choir, hand bells, Sunday school, and also served in a number of other ministries of the church. She was also active in volunteer work at Tuesday House and the Lighthouse. She enjoyed reading and spending time with friends and family.

Mrs. Snyder is survived by her son Andrew Snyder and his wife Larissa of McKinney, Texas, and their daughter Emily Kate Snyder, also of McKinney, a sister Nancy McFarlin of Goodland, Kansas, and nieces Rebecca and Jennifer McFarlin.

She was preceded in death by her parents DeLoss and Mary Beth Starke.
