Barbara Carol Brown, 48, resident of Bartlesville, died Tuesday, April 29, 2014 in Bartlesville.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, May 6, 2014 in the Grace Community Church with Dr. Rod MacIvaine officiating. Interment will be in the White Rose Cemetery under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Barbara was a third grade teacher with Ranch Heights School for twenty-one years and Teacher of the Year in 2007-2008 for the Bartlesville School

System. She was married to Lance Brown on June 29, 1989 at Bartlesville. She was a member of the Grace Community Church and the Anna's Bell's Ovarian Cancer Group of the Tulsa area. There is also an existing Bracelet for Barbara's Donation Website established at Arvest Bank.
