Barbara Lee Ross, 71, spent her early years in Coffeyville, Kansas. In the 1970's she moved with her mother to Tulsa, Oklahoma and had most recently resided in Bartlesville.

Barbara graduated from Roosevelt Junior High and attended Field Kindley High School in Coffeyville. While a member of the EUB/Methodist Church of Coffeyville she received many perfect attendance awards. She was currently a member of Boston Avenue Methodist Church in Tulsa.

While in Tulsa, Barbara served for many years as a 'Pink Lady' at St. Francis Hospital and was recognized for thousands of hours in volunteer service. She also received the Harmon Foundation Outstanding Tulsa Volunteer Award for work as a teacher's aid to children with special needs. Having been nominated by the Tulsa Public Schools, a generous cash donation was

presented to Skelly Elementary School in her honor.

Barbara was preceded in death by her parents Wilma May and Wilbur Alonzo Ross.
