She loved helping children read and even volunteered in Nowata Elementary until her health declined. Delbert and Barbara lived on the farm in Turpin, OK for 42 years. In 2012 they moved to Nowata, OK to be closer to their children. Soon after moving to Nowata, they started attending the First Church of God in Nowata and enjoyed it very much. It was important to her to have and be active in a church home.

Barbara is preceded in death by her parents, and one brother, Roger Clinesmith. She is survived by her husband, Delbert Trahern, Nowata.
