Betty Lou Bevard-Bleichner, 75, of Bartlesville, died at 8:10 A.M. on Sunday, April 4, 2021 at The Journey Home in Bartlesville.

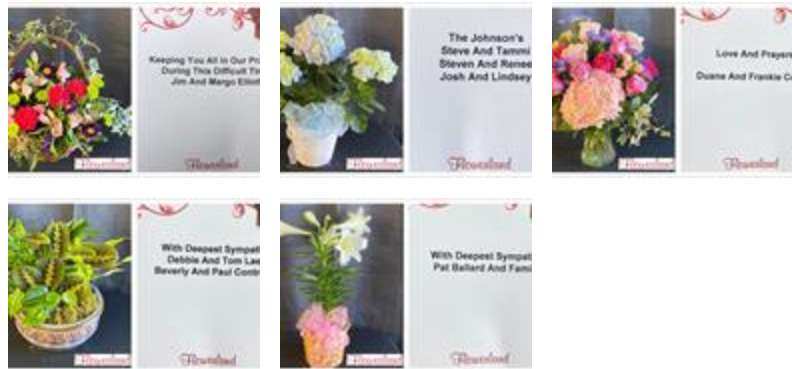
