Mrs. Betty Jean Lovendahl, 88, of Bartlesville, died at 5:45 A.M. on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 at The Journey Home in Bartlesville. 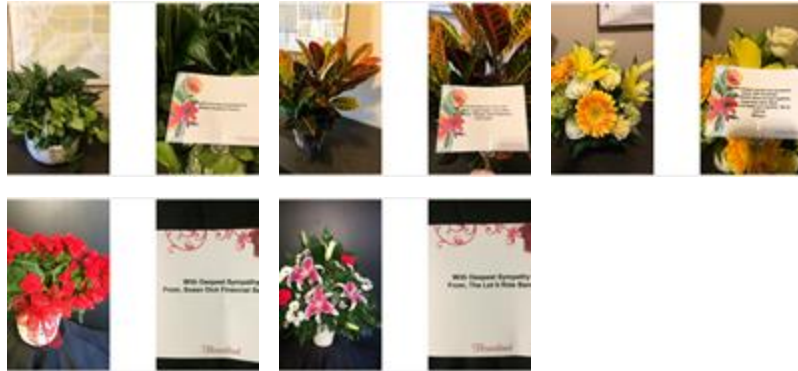
