Beverly June Allen, 85 homemaker, died Friday, July 29, 2016 at 3:20 pm in Bartlesville.

Beverly was born June 6, 1931 in rural Nowata County to parents Ruth Nadine (Smith) and Clifford Auburn Lilburn. Beverly married Carl Franklin Lewis on August 5, 1947 in Nowata County.
