Mr. Billie E. Sanders, 83, of Dewey, died at 2:30 P.M. on Monday, January 7, 2013 at the Forrest Manor Nursing Home in Dewey.

Funeral services will be held at 2 P.M. Thursday, January 10, 2013 with Rev. Mark Bright officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

He moved to Bartlesville in 1968 and was employed with Rogers Electric Company until 1978. In 1978 he was employed with Phillips Petroleum Company as a security officer until his retirement in 1986. He was then employed as a detention officer with the Bartlesville Police Department from 1987 till 1997 and then as the butcher block supervisor at Albertson's Grocery. He was first married to LaVonne Kesner and they made their home in Tulsa and Bartlesville. He later married Shirley Lee Howard at Iola, Kansas on February 14, 1982. They made their home in Dewey and then Kimberling City, Missouri until returning to Dewey. She preceded him in death on April 8, 2009.
