



## Billy Monroe Hawk

August 25, 1931 - March 5, 2017

Mr. Billy Monroe Hawk entered God's Heavenly Kingdom in the early morning hours of March 5, attended by his daughter Connie and her husband. Graveside services will be held at 2pm Wednesday March 8th at the Memorial Park Cemetery with Pastor Chris Morton of the East Bartlesville Christian officiating.
