Billy (Bill) Mack Simmons was born March 30, 1939 to Rhoda Mae Walker Simmons and Jessie Monroe Simmons in Zion, Arkansas. He was the youngest of 10 children. He joined his Risen Savior on April 19, 2017.

A funeral service will be held at the Dewey United Methodist Church on Tuesday, April 25 at 10:00 am.

Bill then started his own business called Bill's Auto Repair in 1978 and it remained opened until July of 2016.

Bill loved working on his "land" and raising cattle. He could be found most weekends riding around on his tractor and "moving dirt." Billy loved being around people and never met a stranger. He "adopted" many people over the years and considered them family members. He joined Dewey United Methodist Church and was a member of the United Methodist Men.
