Mrs. Blanche E. Sumpter, 91, a resident of southeast Bartlesville, Oklahoma, died at 6:35 P.M. on Monday, October 15, 2018 at The Journey Home in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mrs. Sumpter will be held at 2 P.M. on Saturday, October 20, 2018 at the New Harmony Baptist Church with Rev. Tom Cox officiating. Interment will be in the Oglesby Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

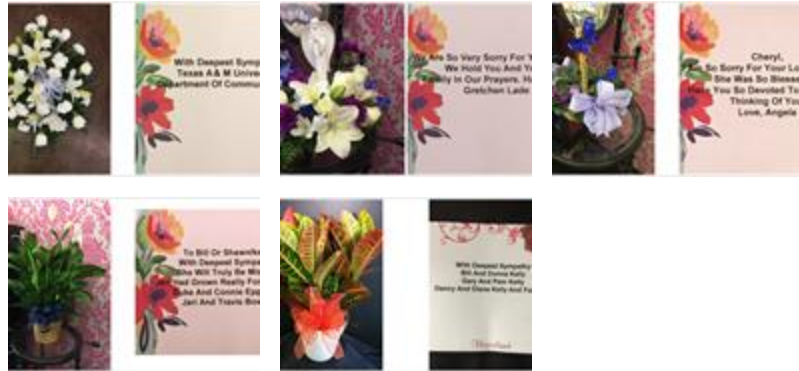
