Bobby Dean Hindman

Mr. Bobby Dean Hindman, 60, of Bartlesville, died at 10:52 P.M. on Saturday, December 31, 2011 at his home.

Funeral services will be held at 2 P.M. Wednesday, January 4, 2012 at the First Baptist Church in Bartlesville with Dr. Joe Dan Fowler officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Hindman was born in Bartlesville on December 31, 1951 the son of Betty Louise (Alexander) and Billie "Bill" Dean Feeler. His biological father preceded him in death on May 30, 1954. His mother remarried to Terry Nathan Hindman, Sr. when Bobby was five. He moved to Nowata County with his family in 1957 and attended Diamond Point Elementary School where he graduated in 1966 and Nowata High School where he graduated in 1970. He then attended Oklahoma State University at Stillwater where he graduated

with a Bachelor of Science in Business in 1974. He was self employed as a building contractor for 33 years DBA Hindman Construction, was a 32 year member of the Bartlesville and National Association of Home Builders and had served as president of the local association in 1987. He had also worked as a school teacher in Wann, Oklahoma and had also been employed at Reda Pump. He was a member of the First Baptist Church for 28 years, including having served on the Building Committee for the new Family Life Center in 2003-04. He coached and sponsored Little League Baseball for 10 years. Mr. Hindman married Nancy Lynn Pierce in Nowata on June 14, 1974 and she was the mother of his 3 children. He later married Diane Sue (Holbert) Franklin on January 21, 1989 in Bartlesville and she preceded him in death on November 3, 1998. He was married to Ina Rosalee (Larrimore) Shane on November 5, 2005 in Bartlesville.
