Mr. Bobby Dean Seat, 86, of Bartlesville, died at 6:30 A.M. on Thursday, December 4, 2014 at his home.

Funeral services for Mr. Seat will be held at 2 P.M. on Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ with Mr. David Hammonds officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery where full military rites will be accorded by the Ceremonial Detail of the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105.
