Mr. McIntosh was born at Pawnee, Oklahoma on September 13, 1944 the son of Vance and Vernie Violet (Brim) Belden. He grew up and received his education at Pawnee where he graduated from Pawnee High School in 1962 and also served in the local Army National Guard Unit. Mr. McIntosh worked as a dispatcher for the Pawnee County Sheriff's Office and the Oklahoma Highway Patrol at the Pawnee Troop Headquarters. He came to Bartlesville where he was a motorcycle patrolman for the Bartlesville Police Department and was then a deputy U.S. Marshal with the U.S. Marshal's Service. In 1972 he was employed with the City of Bartlesville in the City Planner's office until 1977 when he became self employed as a contractor. Mr. McIntosh was married to Kerry April Kelly on July 14, 1977 in Bartlesville. They made their home in Bartlesville until moving to the Ramona/Ochelata area in 1978. Mr. McIntosh was an active member of the Word of Truth Fellowship where he served as Trustee. He loved to work on his Classic Mustang. He was a wonderful husband, father, grandfather and friend and he adored his grandchildren.
