Dr. Carla Deanne Waller-Schauberger, 40, of Bartlesville, went to be with the Lord at 5:18 A.M. on Thursday, April 4, 2013 at the Jane Phillips Medical center following a sudden illness.

Funeral services will be held at 11 A.M. on Monday, April 8, 2013 at the Grenola Christian Church at Grenola, Kansas with Pastor Justin Bates officiating. Interment will be in the Greenlawn Cemetery at Grenola, Kansas directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

The family will receive guests for visitation at the Stumpff Funeral Home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma on Sunday, April 7, 2013 from 3 P.M. until 6 P.M. Dr. Waller was born on August 4, 1972 at Winfield, Kansas to Carl Dean and Patricia Margaret (Andrews) Waller. She received her education at Cedar Vale, Kansas where she graduated from high school in 1990. She attended college for her undergraduate work at Southwestern College in Winfield, Kansas where she graduated in 1994 with a Major in Biology and a Minor in Music. She then attended the Kansas City University of Medical Bio Sciences and received her Doctorate in Osteopathic Medicine in 1998. She then did her

residency in the University of Oklahoma Rural Medicine program located at the Caney Valley Clinic in Ramona. Following her residency she worked for the Mayo Clinic at Waukon, Iowa for five years. She then returned to Ramona where she was the assistant director of the Caney Valley Medical Clinic. She worked as a hospitalist with the Jane Phillips Medical Center in Bartlesville and then as a family medicine doctor with the Gemini Medical Clinic/Jane Phillips Medical Center. She married to Kurt William Schauburger in Grenola, Kansas on November 25, 2006. She loved to travel, explore new places and "loved being a Mom". She was also a mentor through the Big Brothers & Big Sisters program to two children, Alex in Waukon, Iowa and Angie in Bartlesville. Her patients were her life and she provided the best medical care possible for them. She will be missed by all who knew her. Her home church was the Grenola Christian Church in Grenola, Kansas and she was a member of the First Wesleyan Church in Bartlesville.
