Carol Anne Moore, age 79, of Bartlesville passed peacefully on Saturday, August 17, 2024, at home with family by her side in Bartlesville, OK. She went to be with her Lord and her son Bo.

Carol, daughter of the late Lester Berry and Jennie Lou “Pennie” Love was born on November 24, 1944, in Montrose, CO. She grew up as a ‘daddy’s girl’ and rode horses everywhere. After graduating high school, she was planning to attend school to become a flight attendant but met the love of her life James Ray Moore. After they married, she travelled all over the United States with James who was a lineman. In 1975, James and Carol moved to Bartlesville, OK and she told him it was time to make a home somewhere so her children could have a stable school environment.

She went to cosmetology school in 1977 and became a hairdresser. James coached boxing for years and Carol became a boxing judge, which she dearly loved. Her home was always open to all the kids, and many remember her for her famous southern biscuits and her hushpuppies. All who walked through the doors of her home remember her for her selfless kind compassion for others, how she made them feel welcome and genuinely part of her family, all of them knew her as “Mom”.

Later in life she helped James and her family build a successful power line

company all while playing an active role in raising her grandchildren. After their divorce, Carol went on cruises with her brother Roger and her mother Pennie. She used to talk often about all the wonderful places they went to and often shared one of her fondest memories was swimming with the dolphins. When it was no longer safe for her mother Pennie to live at home alone, she moved back to Colorado to care for her mother until she passed. In 2020 she moved back to Oklahoma to live with her daughter Jimmie and husband Buddy. She used to say often when some event would occur, it's a good thing that I pray for my family every day and she did in her own quiet way when no one else was around.
