Carol always had a smile on her face and was a joy to be around. Carol loved

to get together with friends and family. A favorite memory is playing rummy cubes and crazy bee and drinking wine together. Carol loved company and welcomed Carol Sue and her family into her home while Carol Sue sold her home and was moving into another home. I've heard that no one truly dies until no one mentions their name for the last time or has memories about them - that will be a long time.

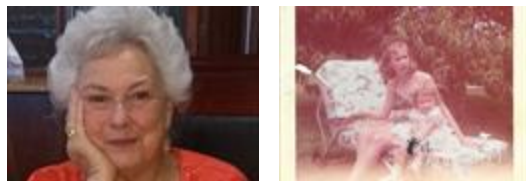
