Catherine Loretta Moore, 92, formerly of Tulsa, died at 4:37 A.M. on Tuesday, April 18, 2017 at the Brookdale South Assisted Living in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mrs. Moore will be held at 2 P.M. on Monday, April 24, 2017 in the Heritage Mausoleum Chapel located in the Floral Haven Cemetery and directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory in Bartlesville.

Mrs. Moore was born at Achille, Oklahoma on February 15, 1925 the daughter of Norman and Grace (Hargis) Griffin. She grew up and received her education in Wynnewood, Oklahoma and it was there that she was married to Earl Kenneth Moore in 1942. They made their home in Wynnewood following Mr. Moore's military service in World War II, until moving to the Oklahoma City area in 1946. They returned to Wynnewood in 1956 where Mrs. Moore

operated her own beauty shop until the family moved to Tulsa in 1963. Mrs. Moore continued to work as a beautician in Tulsa until her retirement at the age of 83. Mr. Moore preceded her in death in 1985 and she continued her home in Tulsa until moving to Bartlesville six years ago. Mrs. Moore enjoyed spending time in the beauty shop with her "ladies", who were dear to her. She enjoyed playing bingo with friends and was known for her cooking and baking. She loved her family and adored her grandchildren.

Mrs. Moore is survived by three sons, Ken Moore and wife Sandy of Bartlesville, Mike Moore and wife Pat of The Woodlands, Texas and Ray Moore and wife Tiana of Broken Arrow, seven grandchildren, four great grandchildren and one great great grandchild. She was preceded in death by her parents, two sisters, Emma Mae Green and Velma Tompkins and two brothers, Kenneth Griffin and George Griffin.
