



Charles Bruce "CB" Hass

March 6, 1930 - August 29, 2011

Charles Bruce "CB" Hass, 81, resident of Nowata, died Monday at his residence.

Funeral services will be held at 1:00 PM on Thursday in the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home Chapel with Brother Wendell Abbott of the First Church of God in Nowata officiating. Graveside military rites will be conducted by the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105. Interment will be in the Fairview Cemetery at Talala, Oklahoma directed by the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home.

Charles Bruce Hass was born March 6, 1930 at Maysville, Oklahoma to Charles and Fannie (Miller) Hass. He grew up in Oklahoma and entered the U.S. Army on August 18, 1947 and served in Korea in the 590th Signal Construction Company where he received two Bronze Stars. Mr. Hass was honorably discharged on September 27, 1951. Mr. Hass was employed as an Iron Worker and a member of the Iron Workers Union Local 584 at Tulsa. He was married to Mary J. Hughes on December 2, 1977 at the Hillside Christian Church in Nowata. They made their home in Nowata for over 33 years and was a member of the First Church of God of Nowata.

Survivors include his wife Mary J. Hass of the family home in Nowata; one step-son Terry Hughes of Grants, New Mexico; one step-daughter Leota Seely of Nowata; one sister Doris Jean Layton of Vinita, Oklahoma; two

brothers Jerry Hass and Berry Hass of Salina, Oklahoma; 6 grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren and 5 great-great-grandchildren. Mr. Hass was preceded in death by his parents; two sons Bud Hass and Gary Hass; one brother Kenneth Burchfiel and a step-daughter Vickie.
