



Dr. Charles Daniel Clinkenbeard

May 12, 1937 - August 18, 2021

Clinkenbeard, Charles Daniel "Charlie", 84, passed away August 18, 2021, at his home, surrounded by family.

Charlie was born on May 12, 1937, in Holton, Kansas to parents Clayton and Helen (Pittenger) Clinkenbeard. Charlie studied Veterinary medicine, receiving his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine from Kansas State University.

On January 25, 1964, Dr. Charlie married Carol Ann Strobel in Topeka, Kansas. In 1965 the young couple moved to Bartlesville where he owned and operated the Clinkenbeard Vet Clinic.

Dr. Clinkenbeard loved spending time with his family, and especially the time he spent coaching his children in football, softball, and basketball. He also enjoyed working on his ranch. Dr. Charlie was a longtime member of the First Wesleyan Church where he had served as a board member.

Charlie was preceded in death by his parents.

Dr. Clinkenbeard is survived by his wife Carol of the home, Daughter Janelle and (Bret) Methvin of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Son Dr. Daniel Clinkenbeard and (Amy) of Edmond, Oklahoma, Daughter Cheryl Clinkenbeard of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, Brother Allen Clinkenbeard (Juanita) of Florida, and 9 Grandchildren.
