Mr. Charles Elbert Steitler, 70, died at 11:10 P.M. on Tuesday, August 5, 2014.

He later worked for Hinkle Mowing from 2000 to 2013. Mr. Steitler was a member of the Copan United Methodist Church, was a former member of the Copan City Council, Copan Volunteer Fire Department and a life member of the Copan FFA.

Moore and her husband Wes of Weatherford, Texas; his mother Vern E.
