Chelsea was born on August 3rd, 1991 to parents Daniel and Dawn Jenkin in Moses Lake, Washington, joining her sister Noel Jenkin and later to become the big sister of Bailey Jenkin. The family made their home in Coulee City, Washington.

In 1999 the family moved to Bartlesville, Oklahoma, where the five of them settled into their new home state. She attended Bartlesville Public Schools and graduated with the Class of 2009. She attended Southwestern Oklahoma State University for 2 years before changing her direction to attend Rhema Bible College to go into Church Ministry. She attended Rhema for 3 years graduating in Pastoral Ministries while interning as Victory Church's Youth Pastor. She was employed by Victory Church in the Youth Department and at Starbucks in Bartlesville as a Shift Manager.

She was starting to gain a reputation for her cupcakes, always looking for new recipes and new frosting options. She loved to experiment and offered samples to whoever would try them, and seemed to have lots of help in the kitchen to lick the beaters or scrape the bowl. Her coworkers at Starbucks, especially, were willing recipients for her newest concoction and the Youth were always wondering what she would make next.

Her Church Family was very important to her, especially the Youth Group. She lived a life of loving people and fulfilled what Jesus admonished us in Mark

12:28-31, loving God with all that she had and loving people. She gave herself to encouraging people and lifting them up and was a vivacious example of the Love of God. Her Mother likes to compare her to the “Winnie the Pooh” character “Tigger”. She is famous for her infectious smile, lots of laughter and incredible hugs.
