Clarence Edward Ebel, Sr., 95 resident of Bartlesville, died at 6:50 A.M. on Saturday October 17, 2015 at the Medicalodge Nursing Center in Dewey.

Graveside Services for Mr. Ebel will be held at 10:30 A.M. on Tuesday at the Memorial Park Cemetery in Bartlesville, with Rev. Duane Johnson and Rev. Keith Acuff of the Bible Holiness Church in Bartlesville officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Full Military Honors were presented at the Gravesite by the members of the Military Honor Guard Detail of the James H. Teel American Legion Post #105 in Bartlesville.

Mr. Ebel was born April 14, 1921 at Medford, Oklahoma to Alex and Martha Hattie (Allday) Ebel. He was raised and received his education at Medford through the 11th grade. He entered the United State Army on August 18, 1942, serving in the Army Air Corps, until his honorable discharge on November 23, 1945. He and Mattie Mae Walker were married on June 29, 1946 at Caney, Kansas and they moved to Bartlesville shortly after that and made their home here all of their married life. Mr. Ebel had worked as a

machinist at Five Star Machine Shop and later Superior Welding in Bartlesville until his retirement. His hobbies were wood working and gardening, duck hunting, and fishing. He and Mrs. Ebel also enjoyed traveling and camping in their RV. He was an active member of Bible Holiness Church in Bartlesville, where he served as a board member, and a Sunday School Superintendant.

Mr. Ebel is survived by his son Clarence E. Ebel, Jr., and two daughters; Kathleen Mae Ebel Caruthers and Maynard Eck of Adair, OK. and Pamela Caruthers and husband Joseph of Bartlesville, OK. Seven grandchildren and fourteen great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife Mattie Mae Ebel in March of this year, and by his parents Alex and Martha Hattie Ebel.
