



## Clarence Edward Henry

February 8, 1923 - December 14, 2016

Clarence E. Henry, age 93, died peacefully at the Claremore Veterans Hospital on December 14, 2016.

Clarence was born on February 8, 1923 in Zoe, OK. In 1943 he joined the United States Army/Marines. He earned the rank of Private First Class as a heavy machine gunner and rifle marksman. He served in the Asian Pacific Theater of World War II and participated in the amphibious landing on Okinawa in 1945, or "Operation Iceberg". He was awarded a good conduct medal and was honorably discharged in January 1946.

Clarence worked at Chevalley Moving and Storage until retirement then was a cattle farmer for the remainder of his life. He was an avid fisherman, farmer, animal lover and beloved father and grandfather.

Clarence was a proud American soldier. He loved this country and what it stands for. He flew the American flag on his farm with honor and respect. He spent his last year in the Claremore veterans home around men who served our country with no question. God Bless America.
