Cynthia (Craig) Wasemiller, lovingly referred to as “Honey” by her cherished grandchildren, went to be with the Lord on Sunday, May 16, 2021 surrounded by her family. Cindy was born on September 7, 1945 in Shawnee, Oklahoma. The oldest of two children, Cindy and her younger brother Robert (who she absolutely adored) were raised by their proud parents, Bob and Sue Craig, in Shawnee. She attended Shawnee High School where she wrote the Shawnee fight song and later attended both the University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University, thus confusing her kids as to where her allegiance actually was. Cindy married Jerry Wasemiller in 1972 and raised their three sons, Craig, Tim, and Kevin in Bartlesville and was an active member of the community over the last 50 years. “Honey” loved spending time with and spoiling her grandchildren, vacationing at the beach, volunteering at countless community events, and watching hundreds of sporting events of her kids and grandchildren. When she wasn’t serving others, Cindy loved to spend time reading books and, according to her kids, wasting time catching up on the latest gossip about the Royal Family. Cindy was diagnosed with Parkinson’s disease in 2019 and bravely fought without much complaint. 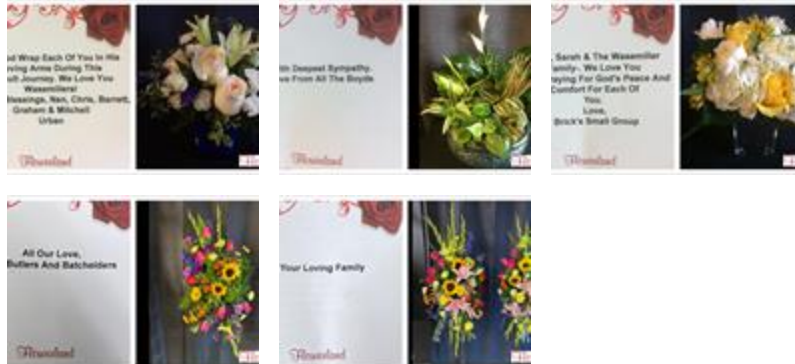
