He also enjoyed photography, camping, working as a volunteer firefighter, and music including the piano, clarinet, and saxophone. He also loved planning his future with his sweet girlfriend, Amanda Holcomb.

He is preceded in death by his great-great grandmother Golda Nelson, great grandmother Alene Honeyman, great grandparents Tommy and Elizabeth Willis, and grandmother Bonita Reynolds..

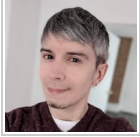

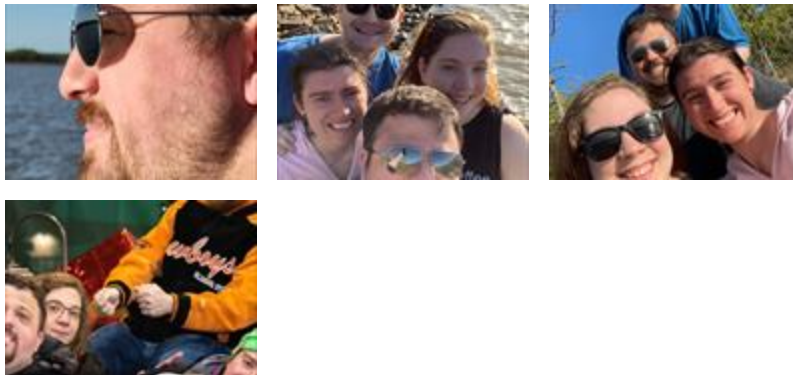
