Darrell Dean Scharosch, 71, resident of Nowata, and longtime owner and operator of D & L Phillips 66 station in Nowata, died Saturday, March 21, 2015 in Nowata.

Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday March 25, 2015 at the Hillside Christian Church in Nowata, with Rev. Gerald McGlauchlen. Interment will be at the Ball Cemetery at Childers, Oklahoma. Funeral arrangements are under the Direction of the Stumpff –Nowata Funeral Home. Visitation will be from 3:00 to 7:00 P.M. on Monday, and 9:00 to 8:00 P.M. Tuesday at the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home.

Full Military honors will be presented at the gravesite by the members of the Bartlesville American Legion Military Funeral Detail, of the James H. Teel American Legion Post #105.

Mr. Scharosch was born February 13, 1944 at Fargo North Dakota to Jacob and Martha Scharosch. He was raised and received his education there and at Billings, where he graduated High School. He entered the U.S. Army in 1963, and served his country during the Vietnam Conflict until his Honorable Discharge in 1972. He was married to Virginia Cunningham on November 6,

1969 at Bell, Texas. They made their home in Texas, and later in Georgia, until returning to Nowata in 1972. They have made their home in Nowata since 1972, where he was the owner and operator of the D& L Phillips 66 in Nowata, for over 35 years. He had continued operating the business until 4 months ago, due to his illness. His Hobbies were going to Auctions and buying and hauling things, and working on his old car.

Mr. Scharosch is survived by his wife Virginia Scharosch, of the home in Nowata, a son Gary Scharosch of Nowata, and by 3 brothers; Mark, William and Laverne, and three sisters, Marie, Ruby and Debbie, by two grandchildren Ryan and Emilea Scharosch, and by numerous other relatives and many friends.
