



## David Edward Beumeler

August 13, 1944 - March 6, 2021

Mr. David Edward Beumeler, 76, of Bartlesville, died at 7:58 P.M. on Saturday, March 6, 2021 at his home in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mr. Beumeler will be held at 1 P.M. on Thursday, March 11, 2021 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Mark Dallalio of the Northside Baptist Church in Carrollton, Texas officiating. Interment will be at 1 P.M. on Friday, March 12, 2021 at the Sunset Cemetery in Sunset, Texas.

The Beumeler family will receive guests at the Stumpff Funeral Home on Wednesday from 6 PM until 8 PM.

Mr. Beumeler was born on August 13, 1944 at Nowata, Oklahoma the son of Joseph P. Beumeler and Christina Oleta (Bolen) Beumeler. He grew up and received his education in Nowata until entering the U.S. Army on August 14, 1961. He served overseas in Germany and following his Honorable Discharge on August 1, 1964 he returned to Bartlesville to make his home. In 1965 he met his future wife, Sharon McKay in Bartlesville. They were married in Bartlesville on January 14, 1966. They made their homes in various locations in Oklahoma, Nebraska and Texas. They eventually settled in Carrollton, Texas for 22 years. Mr. Beumeler was employed as a child welfare worker for the State of Texas until his retirement. Mrs. Beumeler preceded him in death on August 8, 2020. Mr. Beumeler returned to Bartlesville to make his home on

October 23, 2020.

Survivors include two daughters, Kristina Smith of Bartlesville and Katherine Beumeler of Cut Bank, Montana, one brother, Frank Beumeler of Stockton, California, two grandchildren, Bryce David Smith of Bartlesville and Colten Smith of Frisco, Texas and his dogs, Boomer and Rocky, and several nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, Miles Beumeler and another brother in infancy and one sister, Mary Barnes.
