Altogether, 10 grandchildren, had Dave and Janie travelling all over the country for hiking, romping around in the woods, discussing action movies, watching baseball games, fishing, marveling at the latest American Girl outfits and critiquing new hairdos and nail polish colors. Dave and Janie's greatest loves and most beautiful treasures on earth are their grandchildren and thanked their heavenly Father every day for those blessings.
