David Gould King, 100, died April 15, 2024. He was born November 10, 1923 in Lakewood, Ohio to Otis and Margaret King.

After high school, David joined the Navy during WWII and was an aircraft mechanic stationed on the Lucien Islands during the war. David married Anna Jean Chupp on July 23, 1955 in Cleveland, Ohio where they made their home.

David was hired by TRW as a mechanical engineer. He was transferred to TRW Reda Pump in the mid seventies and he and Anna Jean moved to Bartlesville. David was an avid reader and constantly studied aviation. Books on quantum physics were light reading to him and he loved his Swedenborigan faith. Since there was not a church of that faith in Bartlesville, he and Anna Jean joined St Luke's Episcopal Church. After his beloved Anna Jean died, David took up flying at age 70 and piloted his own Cessna taildragger on many trips to visit friends across the country. He finally gave up his license at the age of 90.

He is preceded in death by his parents, his older brother, his wife Anna Jean, and his stepdaughter Carol Ann Brooks.

He is survived by close friends- Penny Williams, Kara Craig, Neil & Kris Loftis, Susie & Steve Clark, and Judy & Tom Chamberlain.

David will be interred at Lakewood Park Cemetery in Rocky River, Ohio. At this time memorial services are pending and will be held at a later date.
