Dewayne Anderson 83 and resident of Copan, OK passed away on December 24, 2022. Dewayne was born January 9, 1939, in Dewey, OK. He was the son of the late Earnie Allen Anderson and Mary Lanora (Tucker) Anderson. He grew up in the Copan area where he received his early education from the Copan Schools. He graduated in 1957 and went on to own his own dairy from 1959-1966. He worked at Reda Pump from 1962-1972. After the death of his father in 1972 in an oilfield accident Dewayne ran Four A Oil Co. along with his mother. Later, Dewayne and his three brothers took over the company. Dewayne owned and operated the company by himself until his death. Dewayne married Sharron Purdum in 1958 and they had three children, Debbie Asbeck, Pam Renee, Lloyd Dewayne.

In 1971 he married Carolyn Hollandsworth, and they had one son, Clint. They made their home in the Copan area and remained there all of their married life.

Dewayne always enjoyed watching and participating in stockcar racing. He owned his own car and raced successfully for several years. He also enjoyed farming and taking care of his livestock.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, Damon Anderson and Doug Anderson, and two children Lloyd Anderson and Pam Anderson.
