Mr. Donald Hampton George, 90, of Wann, died at 3:30 A.M. on Friday, July 29, 2016 at his home.

Services will be held at 10 A.M. on Tuesday, August 2, 2016 at the Ridn' for the Brand Cowboy Church at Wann. Interment will be in the Wann Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. George was born at Wayside, Oklahoma on July 25, 1926 the son of Lee Roy and Lorene V. (Enloe) George. He grew up and received his education in the Wayside and Wann areas and graduated from Wann High School. He entered the U.S. Army on January 25, 1945 and served during World War II, receiving his Honorable Discharge on June 10, 1946. He was married to Alma Jane Hastings at Coffeyville, Kansas on June 11, 1948. They have made their home in the Wann area since that time. Mr. George had been active as a carpenter in the Bartlesville area until 1967. Since that time he has been active in farming and ranching. He was a member of the Delaware Masonic Lodge # 477 where he was a Master Mason and was also a member of the National Rifle Association. He loved to fish and hunt elk, deer, antelope and bear and was active in mountain man rendezvous.

Mr. George is survived by his wife, Mrs. Alma Jane George of the home, three

children, Melinda Valadez and husband Tom of Wichita, Kansas, Gary George and wife Nancy of Wann and Bonnie Miller and husband Darrell of Nowata, one sister, Oma Brinker of Wann, seven grandchildren, Melissa DeVivo and husband Nick, Justin George and wife Kimberlee, Heather Weber and husband Brad, Tonya Merchant and husband Tim, Elicia Stapleton, Hampton Stapleton and wife Heather and Amanda Valadez, and nine great grandchildren.
