Mr. Donald William Pryce, 71, of Ramona, died Sunday, June 26, 2016 at his home.

He enjoyed sports with his grandchildren and working at his property on his big orange tractor. He also enjoyed spending time with family and his weekly breakfasts with his brothers.

He was the rock of his family, the family caretaker and had a strong faith. Mr. Pryce is survived by his wife, Linda Marie Pryce, one daughter, Dawn Marie Pryce and companion, Chad Hauser of Caney, Kansas, one brother, Larry Pryce of Sand Springs, five grandchildren, Ashley Ellis and husband Darren, Dakota Hines, Austin Hines, Danielle Hines and Hunter Hines and three great grandchildren, Arianna Licht, Aaron Ellis and Chase Ellis and several nieces and nephews.
