Mrs. Dora Mae (Dodie) South, 102, of Bartlesville, died at 5:25 P.M. on Saturday, May 15, 2021 at her home.

Mrs. South was born at Dewey, Oklahoma on January 19, 1919 the daughter of Floyd and Anna Marie (Lasure) Harrison. She grew up and received her education in Dewey and graduated as the Salutarian of the Dewey High School Class of 1937. She was married to Joe W. South on April 15, 1942 at her parents home in Dewey.
