They moved to Oklahoma City in 1946 and returned to Bartlesville in 1948. Clyde was employed at the Bartlesville Police Department from 1953 until his retirement in 1981 and Doris was employed with Southwestern Bell as an operator and clerk until her retirement in 1981. Clyde preceded her in death

on December 5, 1986 and Doris continued her home in Bartlesville until moving to Tulsa in 2001 and then to her daughter's home at Locust Grove in May of 2013. Clyde and Doris were former members of the Sixth & Dewey Church of Christ in Bartlesville, former members of the Dewey Church of Christ where they were active in the bus and children's ministries and she was a current member of the of the Pryor Church of Christ. Doris was a great seamstress and had made all of the attendant's dresses for her granddaughter's wedding.

Doris is survived by two daughters, Glenda Howard and husband John of Locust Grove and Cindy Cottrell and husband Floyd of Collinsville, three brothers, Charles Wesley Kerns of Bartlesville, Ronald L. Kerns of Skiatook, and Larry D.
