Mrs. Dorothy Lou Hallaway, 82, a longtime Bartlesville resident, died at 7:32 P.M. on Saturday, July 18, 2015 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center.

Services for Mrs. Hallaway will be held at 11 A.M. on Wednesday, July 22, 2015 at the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ with Mr. David Hammonds officiating. Memorial services and cremation will be under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

They have made their home in Bartlesville most all of their married life. Mrs. Hallaway had been active as a professional artist for many years, with several of her pieces being award winners and developing collectors worldwide. She was a member of the Adams Blvd. Church of Christ (formerly 6th & Dewey Church of Christ), was on the Board of Directors of War Eagle in Arkansas, was a member of the Bartlesville Art Association and was

instrumental in the organization and startup of Sunfest.

Mrs. Hallaway is survived by her husband, Emmett Dudley Hallaway, her three children, Jerri McCollum and husband Dennis, John Russell (Rusty) Hallaway and wife Jennifer and E.
