Mr. Douglas Simon Sherwin, 96, of Bartlesville, died at 9:50 A.M. on Monday, February 9, 2015 in Bartlesville.

No services are planned and cremation arrangements were directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Douglas Simon Sherwin was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on April 16, 1918 to Benjamin Franklin Sherwin and Tillie (Schnitzler) Sherwin. He attended schools in Long Island, New York and graduated from high school at Lawrence High School on Long Island. He attended Stevens Institute of Technology at Hoboken New Jersey and then Pennsylvania State College at State College, Pennsylvania earning a Bachelor's degree in Chemical Engineering and later Oxford University in Oxford, England where he received Bachelors and Master degrees in Philosophy, Politics and Economics. He was employed with a chemical company in Newark, New Jersey and later transferred to Phillips Chemical Company in Bartlesville to help design and operate a butadiene plant in Borger, Texas. He was a civilian wartime government employee during World War II, loaned to the U.S. forces by Phillips Petroleum Company. He was married to Joyce Llewellyn McCarthy on August 22, 1946 in Saltillo, California. They later made their home in Lexington, Kentucky where he was president of Phillips Products Company and later moved to Bartlesville and retired from Phillips in 1985. Mrs. Sherwin preceded him in death on April 8, 2013.
