Dwight R. (Bud) Hudson, 97, WWII Navy Veteran, passed away Friday, December 14, 2018 in Barnsdall, Oklahoma.

Bud served 5 years in the U.S. Navy reaching the rank of Gunners Mate 2nd Class. He served in the South Pacific on the USS Charrette. Dwight, the son of Lillie Cain and Homer Hudson, was born May 13, 1921 in Berry, Alabama. He married Willie M. Gilbert on July 9, 1947 in Carbon Hill, Alabama. Dwight served the City of Barnsdall for a number of years.
